Innovative solutions often start with a strong foundation in mathematics. WSMA is a student-run nonprofit organization that seeks to empower the next generation of problem solvers by promoting math education beyond standard school curricula. We work closely with local students, teachers and math clubs, enabling them to pursue an interest in mathematics by providing convenient access to opportunities, guidance, and resources.

What specifically does WSMA do? Here are just a few of our many services:

- We unify the local math community by creating and sustaining a statewide network of math students and educators.
- We promote mathematical discovery through our annual WSMA Math Fair, our science fair-esque event for elementary and middle schoolers.
- We foster a love of problem solving by reaching out to elementary school students and teaching them practical math skills at our Math Expos.
- We **guide** math clubs to success by creating a centralized database of pertinent resources, including past contest problems/solutions, event details, leadership advice, and other educational materials.

Sponsoring Math Fair

Math Fair is WSMA's biggest event of the year, with over **200 elementary and middle schoolers** registered to explore math or compete in projects. This science fair-styled event will be filled with math activities like math themed escapes rooms, geometric arts and crafts, math bingo, etc. and offers the perfect opportunity for sponsors to advertise their products to excited parents and students. Costing roughly \$3,000 to run, with low registration fees for competitors and no entrance fee for the community, Math Fair relies on sponsorships and donations to ensure that price is not a barrier to mathematics. To this end, we provide sponsors with a physical space to advertise their organization for contributions of \$250 as a Silver Sponsor. Larger donations of \$500+ and \$1,000+ are also needed -- and to show our thanks for your support, you will receive extra visibility and recognition at the event as one of our Gold or Diamond Sponsors.

Bronze Sponsor (\$100-\$249)
